## NEVADA LAFCO RESPONSES TO 2023-2024 Nevada County Civil Grand Jury Report

"FIRE! – Challenges of a Small, Rural Fire District" Report Release Date: June 7, 2024

This response to the Grand Jury's Recommendation #5 was approved by Nevada LAFCo at their September 26, 2024, meeting.

## Response to Recommendation #5:

**R.5.** The Local Agency Formation Commission should conduct a thorough review of the issues this report presents and strongly consider consolidating Ophir Hill Fire Protection District with other districts by June 30, 2025.

## This recommendation has been implemented.

Recommendation #5 suggests LAFCo conduct a thorough review of multiple issues outlined in the June 7, 2024, Grand Jury Report. The issues in the report are addressed in the most recent Municipal Services Review (MSR) conducted to analyze fire district operations – countywide – and therefore, includes the Ophir Hill Fire District.

Additionally, the Ophir Hill Fire District Board voted at its May 13, 2024 board meeting to engage with three other Nevada County fire districts in a reorganization effort which may result in a consolidation of Nevada County Consolidated Fire Protection District, Penn Valley Fire Protection District and the Rough & Ready Fire District.
